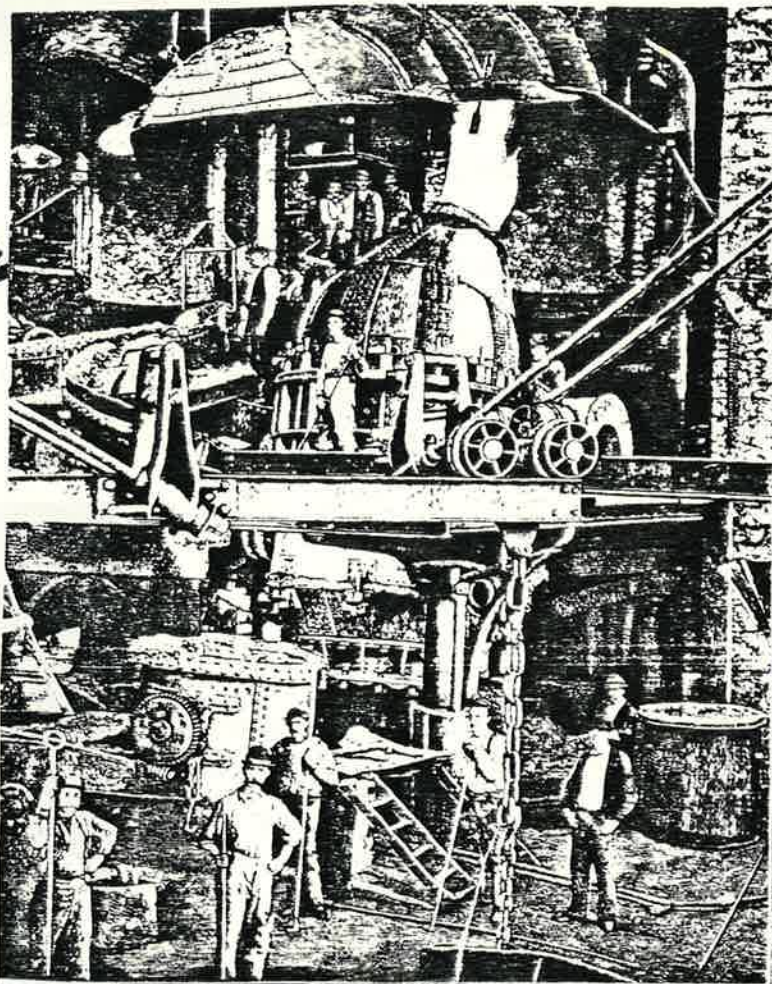
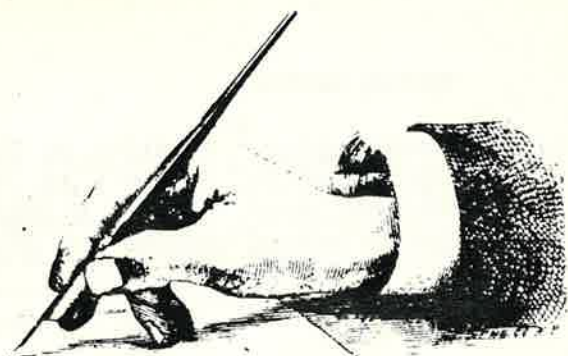


The People Who Make SAS Work

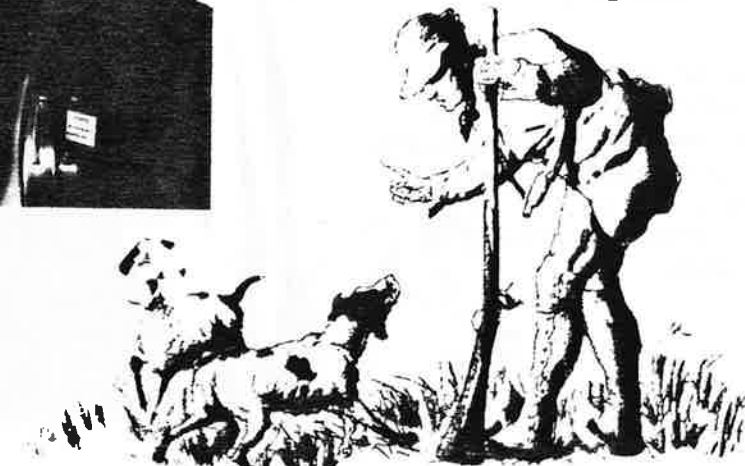
VAUGHN DASHIELL

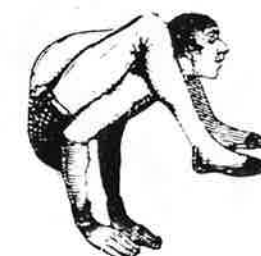
EFRAIN M. GUZMAN
