Update on Saints Athletics Livestreaming

As you may or may not know, this school year, we have been livestreaming home games to the best of our abilities using iPads and cellular data (when outdoors) or school Wi-Fi (when indoors). This setup works well when using Wi-Fi but not so well when using cellular data—outdoor livestreaming tends to lag so much that it almost makes the stream unwatchable, and also leaves teams and athletes without game film to review or utilize for college recruiting highlight reels. We have been working all year to arrange for a more sustainable, workable livestreaming solution for the school, and we hope to have something up and running in the coming weeks. For the time being, instead of streaming spring home games with terrible lag, we will be recording all home games and uploading them to our school YouTube channel after the fact. Thank you for staying patient with us as we work toward an athletics livestreaming solution!



Saints Compete at Delaware Valley Science Fairs

Danny Yu '24 and Oscar Ji '24 presented their independent research in this week's <u>Delaware Valley Science Fairs</u>. Danny's research explores the "dysregulation of alternative splicing as it relates to major depressive disorder"; Oscar's research explores "mechanical inflation device for rehabilitation after arm injury." (In other words, Danny said, their research is about "gene mutations that affect depression and a device that helps lift and bend injured arms.") "Both of these individuals have put forth a tremendous amount of effort towards these projects," said physics teacher Chris Sanchez. Oscar's project was awarded with second place in the Engineering category!

Residents of M Dorm took an 11:00 p.m. fire alarm in stride on Thursday.


